

'How to report a road or pavement issue online' guide

Reporting issues and viewing case updates


Online reporting enables you to:

- create an account, saving you time when reporting and keeping a log of your submitted reports.
- use the map to check if the issue has already been reported and view the status of current open reports.
- subscribe to updates about existing reports by viewing them on the report form map, selecting the pin for the report and submitting your email address.

To receive progress updates you must register for an account or provide an email address when you submit your report.

Step by step guide:

Go to the West Sussex County Council Website at www.westsussex.gov.uk and you will be presented with this page.






Click on 'Roads and travel'. Which will lead you to the following:




Click on 'Make an enquiry or report a problem with a road or pavement'. The following will then show with several different options for you to report.






Once you get to this screen, it would be ideal for you to favourite the page so you can access it easily next time. You can do this by clicking on the star icon circled in the below photo.




It will come up with the following where you can choose your preferred file name and save this favourite/bookmark in the appropriate folder you would like to save it in.






Or if on a mobile device, click on the three dots as circled in below picture.



Then you click on the star icon as circled below and this will bookmark the page for you. To find the bookmark page either now or at a future date, select the 3 dots again (as above) and then click on bookmarks and the web page will be displayed for you to select.






Back to how to report a road or pavement issue e.g. a Flooding, blocked drains and gullies;

Click on 'Report flooding, blocked drains or gullies online' and you will be redirected to the following screen and the online reporting form.

Report problems with flooding, blocked drains and gullies.



Please note, each landing page displays links to the appropriate web online form for the specific issue you want to report e.g. potholes, overgrown vegetation etc.






Before you continue, we would recommend registering for a WSCC Account (please see notes at start of this 'How to Guide') You can if you choose report anonymously and continue without an account.

To receive progress updates you must register for an account or provide an email address when you submit your report.

The following screen will show and you will be asked to fill in your email address and create a password.




Once you have created an account you will be taken to this page where you can report your road or pavement issue.






You will be asked to upload a photo if you have one, search for the address (search for road/town) and/or you can click on the map using either the touchscreen or mouse wheel to zoom in/out and place a locator pin on the map on the relevant road indicating the location of the issue.



You will then be asked for further information regarding the issue you are reporting as below







Next it will ask if you would like to receive updates on your report and if so ask for your details so the Highways Team can keep you informed of progress regarding the reported issue.
